


Health Information Exchange – HIE

View information hospital and GP data about your clients within Mosaic

<p>Overview</p>	<p>Within Mosaic, the link to HIE allows a worker to view information from their client’s GP record, and data from other Trusts and health and social care providers. This information is real-time and read-only.</p> <p>Data will not normally be available if the GP surgery or organisation is not yet sharing information with us, or if the client has opted not to share their data. However, client opt-out has been temporarily revoked in light of the current Covid-19 situation, so all records will currently be available. At the current time, records should only be accessed for the purposes of supporting clients through Covid-19, and not for any other reason.</p> <p><u>Under no circumstances should you print out, screen grab, photograph, or copy by any other means, any information from HIE.</u></p>

<p>1</p>	<p>In Mosaic, open your client’s record.</p>

<p>3b</p>	<p>NB. The record should only be accessed for the purposes of supporting a client through Covid-19</p> <p>Cerner HIE usually requires that you have consent from the person to access their medical records, or ask you to provide a reason to override the lack of consent and provide a comment. However, in the current situation, under the Coronavirus Act 2020, you do not need to ask the client’s permission to look at their record, as long as you are only accessing it for the purposes of supporting them through the current</p>

COVID-19 situation. To reflect this, there is currently only one option in the consent dropdown but this will change in the future.

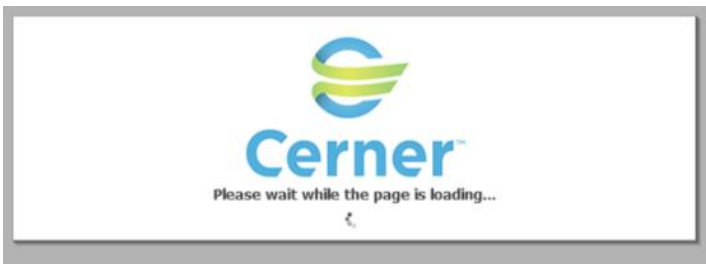

4a **GP DATA**
If GP data is available for the client, it will be displayed in the GP Records section, in the results menu. Each of the headings contains a summary of information.
(Note: the date displayed is the date the summary on HIE was created, not the date of the detail within.)

4b You can drill down into any of the results, just by clicking on them.
