

Adults Privacy Notice Guidance

The Privacy Notice shows people the information collected about them, how we may share their information, how long we keep their information, and their rights.

This form is found in your Mosaic workflow, at the likely first points of contact- such as Conversation 1, Safeguarding Adults– Initial Enquiry, Carer Conversation and Request for CLDS Health Intervention.

Please note, there are three versions of the Privacy Notice on Camden Care Choices: a longer (full) version which shows all the statutory duties, a shorter version that says the basics and the easy read version. - It is a mandatory form within the workflow step, and details the whole Privacy Notice in this section.
