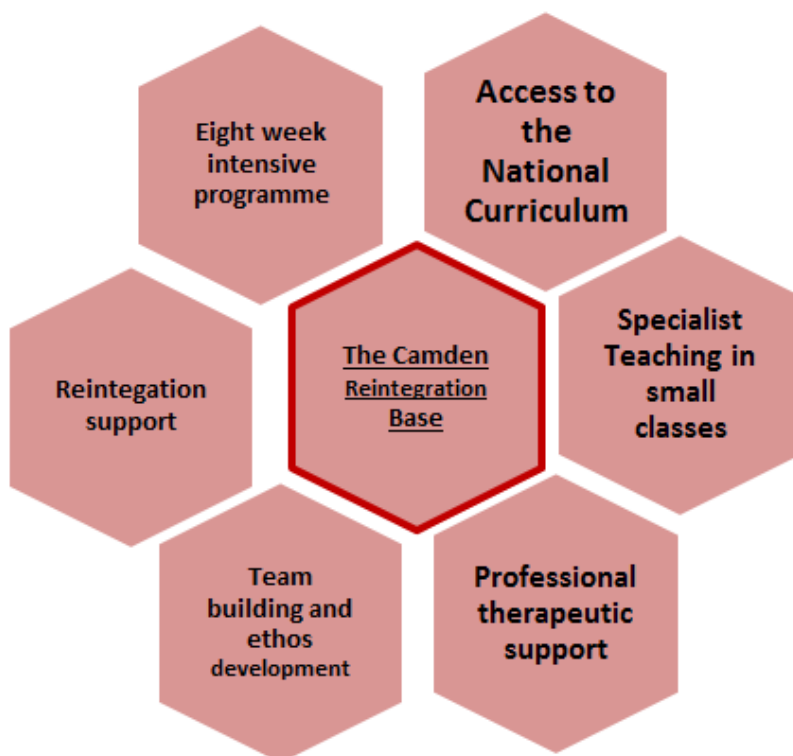


## Camden Reintegration Base Programme

An **eight week** programme for Camden secondary students in **Years 7-9** who are at risk of permanent exclusion. The programme will run four times per year with placements commencing in Weeks 3, 13, 22 & 32 (TBC). There will be two weeks between placement cycles to allow for careful reintegration of students completing the programme and planning for the integration of new CRIB students.

Students will arrive at the CRIB in school uniform at **9.15** every morning and leave at **2.15 pm (1.45 Fridays)**. Students will be taught the **National Curriculum** for three hours per day by in English, Maths, Science, Humanities (Geography & History), PE, Music & Drama by subject specialists wherever possible. The remainder of the time will be used for **Character Development & Awareness group** sessions and personalised **therapeutic support** in partnership with a range of providers including CAMHS, Coram, Camden Prevention, QC Youth Centre & Arsenal. The provision will be tailored to the needs of each cohort.

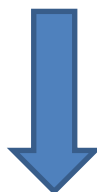

### Referral process

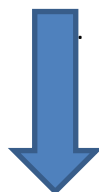
**Documents (passport and risk assessments) sent to schools with referral process. Reminder of criteria. Name of person with overall responsibility to be passed to AAHT**

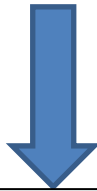

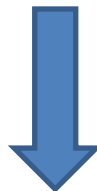

**Safeguarding process sits within the Haverstock safeguarding policy.**

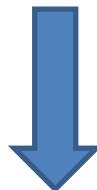
