Good morning to you, I hope you and your families are doing okay.

This is the last email bulletin of 2020. It is not the one I thought I would be sending to you. The announcement of new Tier 4 restrictions on Saturday evening will have come both as no surprise and a big shock all at the same time. I know how hard it is for those of us who cannot now see family and loved ones at Christmas, and to have found out at such a late stage. I'm so sorry this has happened.

There can be little doubt that such intensive measures, taken at such speed, are an indication of how concerned the Government and Health officials are. Two of my friends are Directors of Public Health and they have been clear that this was a necessary, though heart-breaking, step to take. I have emailed you all separately about the new Tier 4 guidance, and there will be a whole service meeting tomorrow morning to brief you on our working arrangements under these new restrictions.

If you have had a tough weekend, please know that you don't have to deal with this on your own. Reach out for help and support if you need to, we are as ever here for you.

Family Early Help Staff Can Now Get Rapid COVID Tests Even Without Symptoms

As an essential worker, you can now get a quick result COVID test called a lateral flow test. Lateral flow tests are a special kind of test that can help identify people who have the COVID virus but do not have symptoms. Test results are available in 45 minutes. You don't need to have COVID symptoms to get this test. You can take the test once every week.

If you test positive, **you and your household must self-isolate** and let your line manager know straight away so they can record it on Oracle. The lateral flow test isn't mandatory and the test result will only reflect if you had COVID at the time you took the test.

Access to these tests is really good news for us, as it gives us another way we can help to keep both ourselves and the families we are helping as safe as possible. That said, I know this is yet another thing to have to think about and plan into your working week, and there may be lots of mixed feelings about the tests. Your managers will be talking with you about this in your 121 supervisions and team meetings, and it's okay to feel lots of different things about the tests. Talk those feelings through with your manager and go from there.

We are now in week 40 of COVID, and whilst our current capacity remains stable we are definitely getting busier as more requests for help come into front door. This is likely to continue into January as we generally have a peak for requests for help a couple of weeks after schools reopen.

Please do all you can to keep yourselves safe and well, and I hope you can find some time to rest and refill your physical and emotional reserves again. Its 100% normal to be fatigued. But we've got important work to do in 2021. We didn't come through all this to let the last 5 miles beat us.

I know your care for Camden children and families is as deep and as wide as mine. We wouldn't do these jobs if we didn't feel that. Let's rest up then keep going – for them.
