We are writing to you as we have identified you as a frontline social care worker working with people who are more vulnerable to COVID-19.

This letter contains important information about the coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccination process, and acts as proof that you are eligible for the vaccine at this time.

The COVID-19 vaccine is being given to frontline social care workers who work with more vulnerable people as a priority. This priority group has been identified by the Joint Committee on Vaccinations and Immunisation (JCVI) because of the critically important work you are doing within your community.

When you go to your vaccination appointment, you must have with you:

- A physical (printed) copy of this letter
- Your work identification badge
- Your NHS number (for more information, see below).

You will be asked for your NHS number on the consent form you will be asked to fill out before receiving the vaccine. You can find your NHS number on any letter or document you have received from the NHS, such as prescriptions, test results, hospital referral or appointment letters. If you cannot find your NHS number at home, please phone the GP you are registered with, who should be able to help you.

It is very important that you take all these things with you, as it will allow staff at the vaccination centre to confirm that you are eligible for the vaccine at this time.
