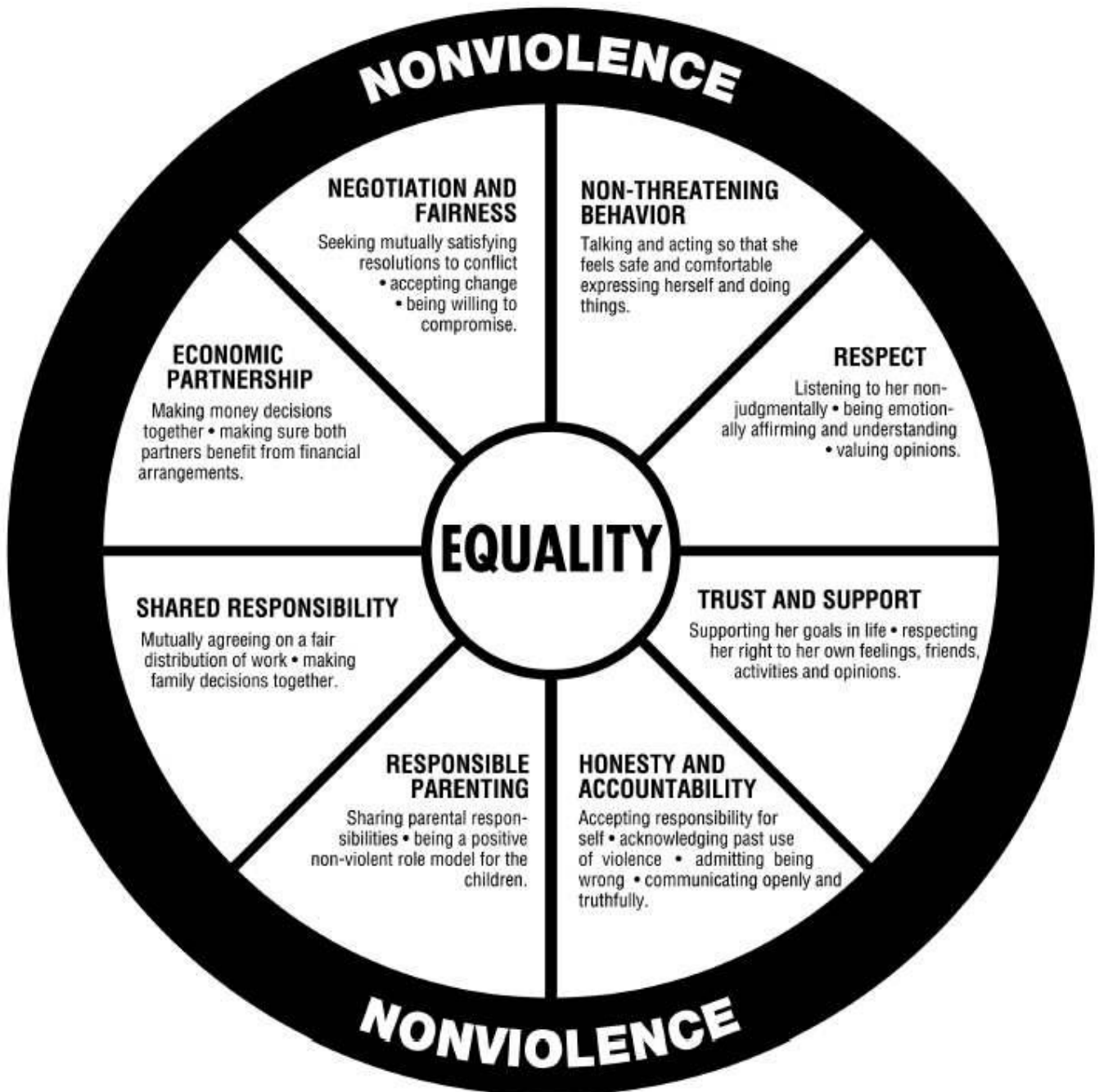
POWER AND CONTROL WHEEL

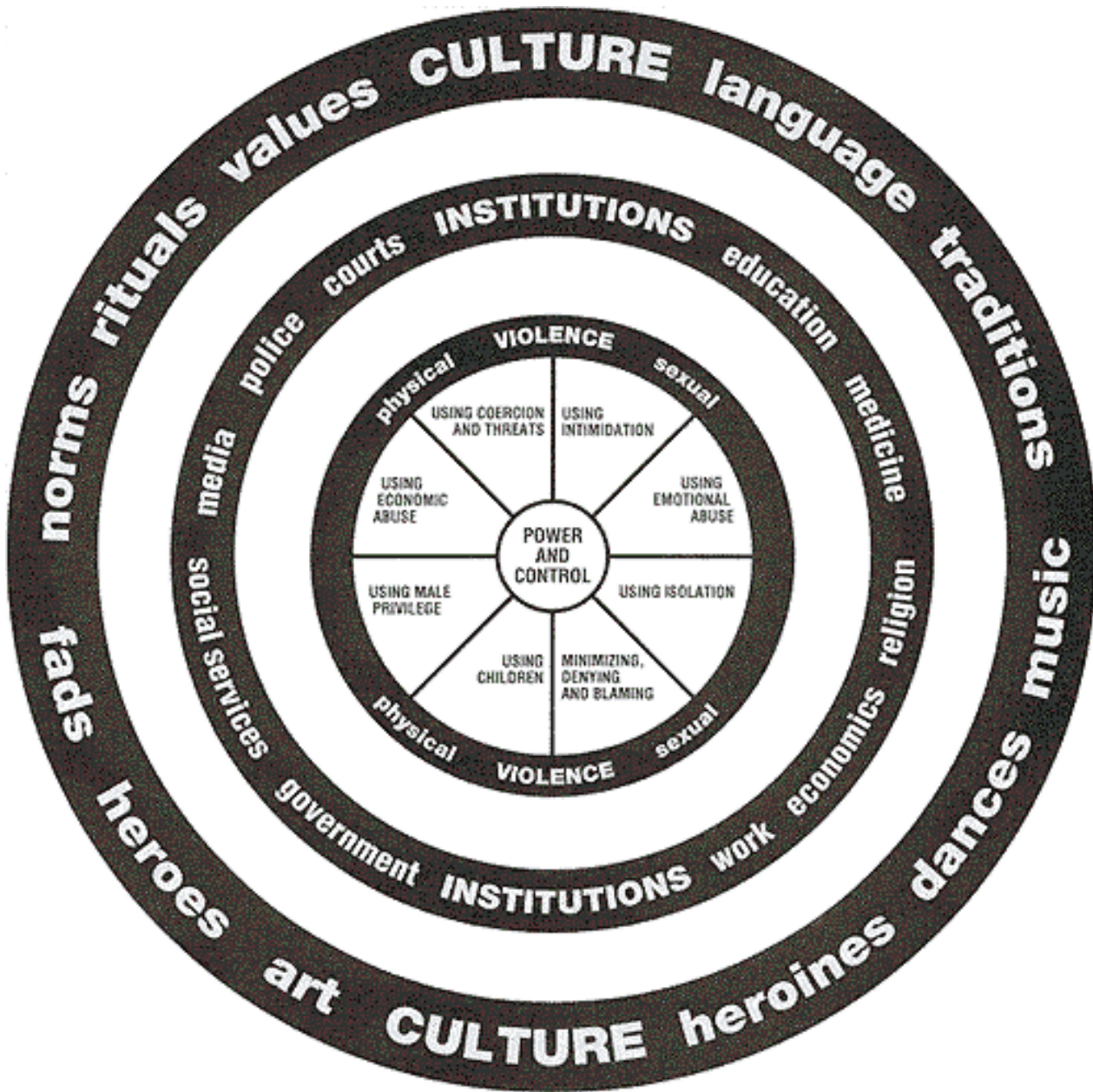
EQUALITY WHEEL
