COVID Email Update 28 June 2021 (dyslexia friendly version)


Good afternoon to you all, I hope you and your families are all doing okay.



Parking Permits

You will have seen on Essentials that the enhanced parking permit scheme, where Camden staff can access free parking permits if their individual risk assessment suggests this is needed, will end on Friday 30 July. Our colleagues in Parking tell us that this is due to the final set of lockdown restrictions due to be eased on 19 July, and the continued rollout of the vaccination programme.

I'm mindful this will affect a number of you who have temporary parking permits, and that you may feel worried about what this means for you. Please do talk with your line manager about it, and particularly update your individual risk assessment. I will gladly take up individual cases with my counterpart in Parking Services if we feel strongly that not being able to use your car for work will have a significant effect on the risk to your health.

NVR Groups Starting Again

The next Non-Violent Resistance (NVR) group from the Tavi's whole family team will be starting again in late September. The programme will run for 13 weeks, and the hope is to make it face to face (but may move online if needed). Families open to the whole family team will take priority, but referrals are welcome as well. If you're working with a young person who is employed, particularly over the summer, please help ensure their employment rights and their children's rights are protected by helping them make sure their employer has this permit.





We are now in week 67 of COVID and our capacity continues to hold steady.

I'll end this week with an image from the first ever presentation I gave in Camden 5 years ago (which was to FIFers!) and its connection with Bronfenbrenner's ecological systems model. Bronfenbrenner believed that there were multiple systems that impact on a child's health and wellbeing and all of them needed to be explored and reflected on.

Thinking about these layers not only helps us to locate the child in their broad community and societal context, but it is also incredibly important to our work on racial justice and equity.
