

## COVID Email Update 27 September 2021 (dyslexia friendly version)

Good morning to you all, I hope you and your families are doing okay. Updates for you this week:

### Use of 5PS


Corporate have now welcomed more staff returning to Camden buildings, and social distancing measures were lifted at 5PS on 13 September. This of course doesn't mean that all COVID-safe precautions have been removed, far from it, and most are still in place. ### Individual Risk Assessments

You may remember back in August, I let you know that Health and Safety had refreshed the individual risk assessment template. I asked your managers to work with you to transfer your individual risk assessment from the old template to the new one. We set ourselves a deadline of 30 September to do this, because all individual risk assessments should be reviewed every 20 working days anyway.
