## Do you currently receive Healthy Start food vouchers?



Healthy Start is changing. It is becoming a digital scheme and is moving from vouchers to a prepaid card.



If you currently receive Healthy Start vouchers, you need to reapply online by **31st March 2022** to continue to receive Healthy Start payments. To reapply, visit www.healthystart.nhs.uk/how-to-apply.

If you are unable to apply online, you can also reapply by calling the National Healthy Start Team on **0300 330 7010**. You can contact your local children's centre if you need further support in applying for a Healthy Start prepaid card. Please go to **camden.gov.uk/childrens-centre-services**, or call Freephone **0800 731 0232** or **0800 389 5789**, to find your local centre.

## **What is Healthy Start?**

Healthy Start supports pregnant women and families to eat well and get the vitamins they need for healthy development.

## Is it for me?

- If you are pregnant, or you are a parent with children under the age of 4, you can get free Healthy Start Vitamins from children's centres.
- If you are also receiving Income Support or other benefits, you could be entitled to a Healthy Start prepaid card of up to £8.50 per week too.
- If you are pregnant and are under 18 years old, you do not need to receive income support to be entitled to a Healthy Start prepaid card.
