If this happens:

- care workers may leave the home they're working in immediately
- the perpetrator's care and support may be suspended or removed.

We record all incidents of abuse and report to the police where necessary.

We all have the right to be treated with dignity and respect.

If you are experiencing any abuse, or you know someone who is, please don't suffer in silence.

Please report the abuse so we can support you.
