Thank you for meeting with us on Tuesday and a warm welcome to Camden. Here is the information you asked for:

Education. You asked about education for F and S. They will be in Reception class and Year 2 class. I have asked which schools have vacancies in those two age groups. I will let you know as soon as possible. You can then call the schools to arrange a visit and see which one you like. The school will help you to do an application for a school place.

Doctor. You asked about registering with a GP. You can do that by asking the nearest GP practice if you can register with them. Your nearest GP surgery is Holborn Medical Centre. You can contact them here Contact - Holborn Medical Centre

Bank account. You asked for help with a letter to prove your new address that would help you open a bank account. I will send you this letter as soon as you are in your new flat. This is to make sure the letter has the right address on it. **When you have your new address, please would you email it to me?**

Benefits. You asked about applying for benefits. This is called Universal Credit. You can apply for Universal Credit online here <u>Universal Credit: How to claim - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)</u>.

You can also call the national Universal Credit helpline on 0800 328 5644 or visit a local Jobcentre Plus (job centre). Your nearest Job Centre Plus is 1 Barnsbury Rd, London N1 0EX, Phone: 0800 169 0190 (the local office number) or 0800 328 5644.

You may be able to apply for other benefits, including Child Benefit. You can find more information about child benefit here Claim Child Benefit: Eligibility - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)

Biometric Resident Permit. You asked how to get your biometric resident permits. This will be evidence of your immigration status while you are in the UK. You will need to submit your biometrics within 6 months of arriving in the UK, and to extend your stay for up to 3 years.



The Government have an online form you can use to start this process. You can find the form here <u>Ukraine Scheme BRP (visas-immigration.service.gov.uk)</u>. Once the Government have received your details, they will tell you how to provide your biometric information.

National Insurance Number. You asked about getting a national insurance number. When you collect your biometric residence permits, they should have a national insurance number printed on the back of the permit card. If they do not, you can contact the National Insurance Number helpline here <u>Apply for a National Insurance number - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)</u>.

Meeting people. You said that it would be good to meet people in your local area. There are lots of events being held at the Ukraine Institute and Ukrainian School which are not far from where you live (contact details below). Camden will be also arranging local meets at a community centre near you. I will let you know as soon as I have more information.

Activities. You asked for information about gymnastics clubs for F. Talacre Gymnastics Club have an artistic squad.
