



Both Camden Learning Disabilities (CLDS) and Camden Young People's Disability Services (CYPDS) manage their own safeguarding referrals and enquiries. For residents who are supported in a placement out of borough and a safeguarding concern is raised, the host borough has responsibility to lead on the enquiry but the relevant Camden team (if Neighbourhoods, this would be the team where the person previously lived in Camden) would be involved, e.g. attending meetings, liaising with family, etc.
