	and for the recruitment of new staff will transfer to the Council, however it is intended that all staff who would like to

	There are no anticipated changes for residents who contribute to the cost of their care at this time.

	Mora Burnet House will work in partnership with the Council's other in-house Extra Care service (Charlie Ratchford			
	Court). Provider Services will work in partnership with the staff and residents of Mora Burnet to explore how the scheme			
	can work more closely with the local community in Swiss Cottage. This may mean that there are some changes to the			
	building and/ or to the activities on site. No changes will be made without the involvement of staff and residents.

	There will be no change in the process for new admissions or referrals to Mora Burnet House at this time. New residents

	presented to the Extra Care Panel for consideration as usual, however this process may be reviewed in the future to

	coming to an end, an opportunity has arisen to explore a number of different options for delivering care to the residents			
	of Mora Burnet House. The two viable options for this service were insourcing or going out to market for a new care			
	provider. Following discussions with a range of colleagues and reflecting on the success of the Council's other in-house			
	extra care service (Charlie Ratchford Court) it has been agreed that in-sourcing has the greatest potential benefits for			
	Mora Burnet House staff and residents.

	Charlie Ratchford Court is built on a wellbeing model of care which demonstrates excellent outcomes by implementing
